This year our priorities for improvement will focus on:

1. Curriculum, Planning for Learning, Teaching and Assessment - Medium Term Planning and Learning for Sustainability

- All staff planning Learning, Teaching and Assessment using our recently developed medium term planning format.
- To have a clear understanding of where we are with our Curriculum.
- In line with our work around The Four Contexts, to develop our curriculum and learning and teaching with a focus on Learning for Sustainability (LfS).
- Staff to develop their skills in bundling Experiences and Outcomes.
- All pupils will engage in one bundle of LfS and have opportunities to develop life skills through Food for Thought initiative and skills development in our Life Skills classroom.



2. Literacy - Reading Pedagogy and Achievement

- Staff will develop their understanding of knowledge and skills in pedagogical approaches to the teaching of reading. By June 2025 **all** teachers will have increased understanding of how children learn to read and will have increased confidence in using a variety of strategies to improve outcomes in reading.
- To develop a literacy rationale/framework that reflects our pedagogy and practice in literacy at Moray PS.
- Increase pupils' skills and ability in reading in First Level CfE.
- By June 2025 most families will engage and feel confident they can support the development of their child's reading and literacy skills.



3. Numeracy - Numeracy Pedagogy and Achievement

- To develop our practice and pedagogy in numeracy and maths, support learning and teaching and improve attainment outcomes and success of our learners in numeracy and maths.
- By June 2025 staff will have developed their understanding of knowledge and skills in pedagogical approaches to the teaching of numeracy and maths.
- By June 2025 staff will have developed their understanding of knowledge and skills in pedagogical approaches to the teaching of numeracy and maths.
- Increase **most** parents understanding of learning and teaching in numeracy and maths and how they can support their child's progress in numeracy and maths.
