Developing a culture of Career Long Professional Learning by creating opportunities for greater collegiate working throughout the whole school community and engagement with professional enquiry and research.



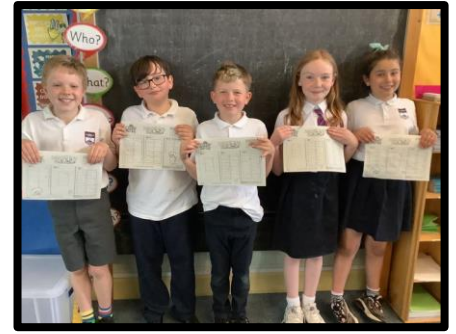
2. Learning and Teaching

Create an environment centred on high quality teaching and learning experiences, focus on pedagogical approaches to support and challenge pupils attainment in literacy, numeracy and health and wellbeing.



3. Planning, Assessment and Tracking of Pupil Progress

Develop practice in using Curriculum for Excellence (CfE) benchmarks and progression pathways to assess pupils' progress in their learning and consistently record and track progress using Falkirk Council CfE Tracking Tool.



4. Health and wellbeing and whole school achievement

Build on positive ethos within the school by ALL pupils and stakeholders committing to shared educational and wellbeing values and sharing and celebrating success.
